Queen Victoria was Queen of England 1837-1901

Background information. Most children did not attend school unless they were rich and went to a private school—there were some in Malvern.

In 1870 you left school at 10

In 1899 you left school at 12

Many people could not read or write.

Only rich went to school.

Famous people came to Malvern for the Water cure.

Great Malvern Station was built in 1860 and Priory Park bandstand in 1875.

Gas lamps were famous in Malvern.
